Dear students, keep yourself aware of the following rules and regulations. as ignorance of rules shall not be an excuse for violation.

1.CODE OF CONDUCT

- Each student shall show due respect and courtesy to the Faculty, Administrators, Non-teaching staffs, patients, visitors, residents of the institute and also good behaviour to fellow students.
- Student's conduct within and outside the campus of the medical college and hospital shall be suitable, as student of a prestigious Medical College, R K Damani Medical College, ShriRamchandra Institute of Medical Sciences, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar.

2.PUNCTUALITY

- · It is important virue of a doctor.
- Students are expected to be seated in lecture hall/ Practical hall, 5 minutes before the commencement of the lecture / practicals.
- · Coming late & leaving early at or from a class are recorded as absence from the class.
- Students should take written permision from authorities before going out of station.

3.BEHAVIOUR

- Students are expected to maintain calm, quiet and peaceful environment in the campus.
- · Maintain the silence while standing or walking in the college corridor .
- Mobile Phones/ Tablets should be kept in flight mode/ switch off during Lecture/ Practical.
- Smoking, alcohol consumption, drug abuse and any kind of misbehaviour or any kind of unlawful
 activity within the campus is prohibited and will be duly informed to the parents besides taking
 strict disciplinary action as per college rules and regulations.

4.ATTENDANCE

- Every student should have a minimum of 80% attendance to be eligible to take the University Examination.
- Maintain 80% attendance for clinical subjects from 3rd term (IInd Phase) till final exam.
- Student should submit leave application for planned leave before leaving the college.(Annexure I)
- Students who are absent on medical ground should produce a valid medical certificate along with the Requisition Letter for leave from Parents.
- Leave taken for any reason cannot be taken into account for attendance, but attendance will be calculated excluding leave.

5.IDENTITY CARD

- All students are expected to wear the identity cards provided to them at all times.
- Students should report loss of Identity Card in writing to the students Administrative officer within 24 hours explaining the circumstances under which it was lost.

6.DRESS CODE

- Dress code is a part of security protocol. All students are expected to wear the prescribed uniform (White shirt & Grey pant/ Salwar Kameez same colour combination) with black shoes on all working days. Students are not allowed to wear T-shirts, sleeveless or shorts for classes other than the prescribed dress code.
- Boys Hair must be neatly cut and combed.
- · Girls- Hair has to be tied up neatly and not left loose.
- Both boys and girls should wear clean white aprons with the college emblem in the college premises. To respect the sanctity of profession please do not wear these aprons outside the college campus.

7.ANTI-RAGGING

- On Directions of National Medical Commission (NMC), published in the Official Gazette notification (G.O) Dt: 18th November, 2021 has ordered strict implementation & regulations for Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in medical college.
- Our institution has zero tolerance policy for ragging.
- Students are instructed to report ragging incidence immediately to any member of the Anti-Ragging committee.
- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-
 - Cancellation of admission
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
 - Rustication from the institution for period rangingfrom 1 to 4 semesters
 - Debarring from appearingin any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
 - Suspension from attending classes
 - Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - Withholding results
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent oensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

8.COUNSELLING (MENTOR- MENTEE SYSTEM)

- Mentoring is an effective and popular way of providing guidance and support to the students and thereby shaping their future.
- Each student will be alloted a mentor at the start of the academic session and there will be scheduled meetings with them.
- Apart from that a student who faces academic or other problems can approach their mentors for resolution.

9. HOSTEL

- Hostel will remain open from morning 6.00 am to evening 8.00 pm. In case of unavoidable delay, student should intimate hostel care taker in advance. However it should be noted that such delay will be permitted only 3 times a month. Disciplinary action will be taken against students found breaking this rule.
- Strict action will be taken against the student who is not found inside the hostel after 8.15 pm.
- No student will be permitted to stay inside the hostel room during the college hours.
- With valid reasons e.g. illness student will be allowed to stay in the visitor's room under the strict observation of Hostel caretaker/ Manager

10. SECURITY

11.ACADEMIC

- As per NMC guidelines each student has to appear in the internal assessment exam before appearing in the university exams.
- Minimum number of internal assessment exams that student should appear in each subject are as follows...
- For pre & para clinical subjects- 3 IA (including prelim)
- For clinical subjects 2 IA per phase starting from phase II
- For FMT 2 (Phase II), 2 (phase III part I)
- For PSM 1 (phase I), 2 (phase II), 2 (Phase III part I)
- To appear in university examination student should score...
- Theory (min 40%); Practical (min 40%); Combine should be minimum 50%
- In case you miss any internal assessment due to valid reasons, you should take permission (Annexure II) from the Respected Dean to appear for the missed IA. Submit photocopy of the permission letter to the respective department. Respective department will arrange for the IA exam as per the rules. Please note students are allowed to avail this benefit only once during the entire duration of the MBBS curriculum (4.5 years).
